



Shelter Rules

Skamokawa Vista Park has two shelters available for rent. They can be reserved by calling the office at 360-795-8605. Reservations are for 8-hour blocks, not to be outside posted day use hours.

1. Park Buildings and facilities are provided for your privilege and convenience. You have a responsibility to use the facilities with respect for others and to keep them neat and clean. Any irregularities should be reported immediately to the Port.
2. All materials including tape, streamers, banners, etc., must be removed thoroughly after each event.
3. No signs shall be posted on the trees or shrubs, nor can any nails, screws, or other foreign objects be driven into the structures.
4. Nothing greater than 5 lbs. shall be attached to or hung on any structures for any reason.
5. Garbage and trash must be placed in the proper receptacles.
6. No person other than a duly authorized Port employee in the performance of his or her duty or persons participating in Port approved activities shall dig, remove, destroy, injure, mutilate, or cut any trees, plants, shrubs, blooms, flowers, or any portion thereof growing in the park.
7. Trees and shrubs are not to be climbed, hung-on, or used as poles for game, nets, or swings.
8. Please obey the posted speed limits. Use extra caution for children and pedestrians.
9. Disturbing or careless operation of motorcycles, automobiles or other types of motor vehicles will be grounds for removal from the parks and/or citation by police.
10. All equipment must be removed after each use of the shelter.
11. Disorderly conduct, abusive language, noisy disturbances or disregard of these rules and regulations will be grounds for your immediate removal from the park by police, security, or authorized Port personnel. It is at the Port's discretion if you will be allowed back on the property.
12. Fires are only allowed in provided and designated fire pits. Pits are not to be moved. Fires are not allowed during a burn ban.
13. Overnight camping is not allowed at either shelter.
13. All other rules, regulations and ordinances are to be followed.
